

**Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Monday, August 14, 2017**  
**6:30 p.m.**  
**Barrett City Office**

Present: Mayor-Les Alvstad; Council-Todd Lang, Earl Janshen, Brian Tucker, Jason Wendt; Clerk/Treasurer-Marita Rhude; Guests: John Hanson .  
Absent: Maintenance-Gerald Puchalski.

Mayor Alvstad called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Visitor Comments: John Hanson commented that he plans to open the Wrap Shack in the beginning of October.

Tucker made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Janshen. MCU

Lang made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 10, 2017 meeting, seconded by Tucker. MCU

Wendt made a motion to approve the Temporary On-Sale Liquor Licenses for the Barrett Fire Department for September 9, 16 & 30<sup>th</sup> at the Barrett Pavilion, seconded by Tucker. MCU

Lang made a motion to approve the MN Lawful Gambling Application for Exempt Raffle Permit for the Barrett Flames Auxiliary with no waiting period, seconded by Janshen. MCU

Tucker made a motion to contract for Propane for the 2017-2018 season with Haley Oil Company for 4,500 gallons at .99 per gallon with .10 per gallon \$450.00 due with the contract, seconded by Lang. MCU

Wendt made a motion to enter into a contract with Johnson-Frykman Lawn Care LLC to provide lawn care service from April 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018 for \$6,160 with optional spraying of city property one application \$1,208.04 or two applications \$1,096.23 each, seconded by Tucker. MCU

Lang made a motion to hire Weets Custom Services for snow removal for the 2017-2018 year (October 15, 2017 to April 15, 2018) at \$18,000 to include a cap of 45" of plowable snow and an additional fee of \$400 per inch after the 45", seconded by Janshen. MCU

The council reviewed a request from the Barrett Fire Department to purchase 3 red shirts for fundraising events for its 2 newest members as well as black & white dress uniforms. Council requested that they come back with prices of the uniforms for next month.

The council reviewed a request from the Barrett Flames to be reimbursed \$50 for washing the City tractor prior to the Barrett Old Settler's Parade where it was used to pull the C & C float in the parade. Alvstad made a motion to reimburse the Barrett Flames the \$50 it cost to wash the City tractor, dies for a lack of second.

The lack of cell service signal in Barrett from Verizon Wireless was discussed by the City Council.

The proposed 2018 budget was reviewed and discussed.

Alvstad made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$30,624.16, seconded by Lang. MCU

Tucker made a motion to adjourn at 7:25 p.m., seconded by Janshen. MCU
