

**Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Monday, July 8, 2019**  
**5:00 p.m.**  
**Barrett City Office**

Present: Mayor-Todd Lang; Council-Jason Wendt, Jodi Moss, Michelle Jenson; Clerk/Treasurer-Marita Rhude; Maintenance-Gerald Puchalski. Guests: Terry Burns, Chris Bartosiewski, Kent Marshall, Troy Johnson.

Mayor Lang called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Moss made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of Temporary On-Sale Liquor Licenses, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Jenson made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2019 council meeting, seconded by Moss. MCU

Chris Bartosiewski, the City Auditor, was present to go over the 2018 Audit and answer questions. Jenson made a motion to accept the audit report as presented, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Kent Marshall was in attendance to discuss his lease for office space with the City. The lease expired in July of 2018. Wendt made a motion to rent office space to Kent Marshall for \$450 per month, seconded by Moss. MCU

Kent Marshall expressed that he felt the Pavilion needs to have a sprinkler system installed. All the Pavilions of the past have burned down. Barrett is one of the last remaining Pavilions. He is willing to help pay for a sprinkler system as a donation to the City. The City will look into the cost of a sprinkler system.

The City Office basement was discussed. The basement has always been wet and with all the rain year we are having this year it is especially bad. It was discussed to remove the carpet and just paint the floor.

2018/2019 snow removal costs went over budget by \$20,400. According to our snow contract those costs will be added into the 2020 Budget and payable next year.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter budget update was reviewed. 2020 Budget preparation is starting and council was asked to consider any items they would like included in the 2020 Budget.

Temporary On-Sale Liquor license procedures were discussed.

The City received a bad check from a Pavilion rental. It was decided to give them a week to pay in cash and if not to turn it into the County Attorney for prosecution.

Moss made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$38,913.34, seconded by Jenson. MCU

Wendt made a motion to adjourn at 6:09 p.m., seconded by Moss. MCU
