

**Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Monday, June 14, 2021**

Mayor Jenson called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Visitor Comments: None

Simpson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Lasch. MCU

Moss made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 10th meeting, seconded by Simpson. MCU

Nathan Feist from Bollig Inc. was present via zoom. He presented Charge Order #3 for the Water Treatment Plant to change the head of piping coming into the water treatment and including replacing flow meter, check vales, gate valves and piping at a cost of \$33,211.74.

Ray made a motion to approve Change Order #3 for the Water Treatment Plant at a cost of \$33,211.74, seconded by Simpson. MCU

Kevin Pettee was present to discuss the utility bill from his water leak. Lasch made a motion to forgive the sewer portion of the bill in the amount of \$533.55, seconded by Simpson. MCU

Moss made a motion to approve a temporary on-sale liquor license for the Elbow Lake Lions for August 28, 2021 at the Barrett Lakeside Pavilion, seconded by Ray. MCU

Lasch made a motion to approve a gambling permit within the City limits for the Knights Wrestling Boosters for September 11, 2021 at the Barrett Lakeside Pavilion with no waiting period, seconded by Ray. MCU

Todd and Kim Lang which to purchase 2 lots in Block 1, Lots 3 & 4 in Beverly Hills Addition. Moss made a motion to sell Lots 3 & 4, Block 1 in Beverly Hills Addition to Todd and Kim Lang with a soft second mortgage, seconded by Simpson. MCU

Council reviewed two bids for replacing the apron in front of the doors at the firehall. Lasch made a motion to go with Lakes Country Concrete for a concrete apron at the firehall at a cost of \$7,000, seconded by Ray. MCU

The City reviewed two requests for Soo Lane. Dale Norris requested speed bumps be put in and Barrett Farm Supply requested the City purchase chloride and they would apply it. The council took no action on these requests.

The future of the Pavilion was discussed. It was decided to form a Pavilion Committee of Community members

to discuss what they want to see done with the Pavilion in the future. Chery Simpson will get 10 community members to serve on this committee and have them report back to the council with their findings.

The Dean Ladwig property was discussed and Marita will follow up with them. Criminal background checks for the fire department have not yet been completed. Jenson will follow up with the Fire Chief on this.

The council had received a request about paving the alleyway by Mark Bruzik's, off 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Council will not be paving any alleyways at this time.

The City Council meetings will be moved back to the City Office starting in July. A smart tv will be purchased for the City Office which allow us to continue to use Zoom when needed.

Simpson moved to resolve to accept the \$300 donation from Bollig, Inc., seconded by Ray. Roll Call Vote: Moss-yes, Simpson-yes, Lasch-yes, Ray-yes, Jenson-yes

Moss made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$59,180.96, check #19134 to Check #19171, seconded by Lasch. MCU

Lasch made a motion to adjourn at 6:57 p.m., seconded by Ray. MCU
