

Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes

Mayor Alvstad called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Alvstad made a motion to approve the Agenda as presented, seconded by Lang. MCU

Janshen made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Lang made a motion to approve the minutes of the Special Council meeting on February 23, 2017, seconded by Janshen. MCU

Lang made a motion to approve two sessions of Right to Know Training for a cost of \$950 with Johnson Safety Consulting, seconded by Janshen. MCU

Wendt made a motion to waive the monetary limits on municipal tort liability established by MN Statutes, Section 466.04 to the extent of the limits of the liability coverage obtained from LMCIT, seconded Lang. MCU

Janshen made a motion to approve the Grant County Humane Society Lost Dog Contract for May 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018 for \$200 for up to 5 dogs and \$40 per dog after the original 5 dogs, seconded by Alvstad. MCU

Lang made a motion to move forward with Bollig Inc. Task Order No. 3 for Railroad Crossing and Storm Sewer Improvements and Final Design of Sanitary Sewer RR Crossing with Permit Application. Preliminary Design of Storm Sewer Improvement Areas for \$34,000, seconded by Alvstad. MCU

Janshen made a motion to approve allowing a raffle for the Barrett American Legion Club, seconded by Lang. MCU

Wendt made a motion to approve the Barrett Inn 2 ½ liquor license renewal for Off Sale \$100, On Sale \$1,400, and Sunday Liquor \$200, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Gerald presented some bids for work on the Community Center. Council felt that the bids should also include new windows. This will be put on next month's agenda. Gerald reported that the well inspections found well #4 has dropped pumping by 35 gallons per minute. The wells have not been pulled in a long time. It costs about \$2,600 per well to pull them for service. This will be put on next month's agenda.

Alvstad made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$24,415.38, seconded by Lang. MCU

Wendt made a motion to adjourn at 7:09 p.m., seconded by Lang. MCU
