

**Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Monday, March 14, 2016**  
**6:30 p.m.**  
**Barrett City Office**

Present: Mayor-Les Alvstad; Council-Todd Lang, Kathy Wevley, Brian Tucker, Jason Wendt; Clerk/Treasurer-Marita Rhude; Maintenance-Gerald Puchalski.

Mayor Alvstad called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Lang made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 8, 2016 meeting, seconded by Tucker. MCU

Wevley made a motion to approve the Grant County Humane Society Lost Dog Contract for May 2, 2016 to April 30, 2017 for \$200 for up to 5 dogs and \$40 per dog after the original 5 dogs, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Tucker made a motion to approve the Barrett Inn 2 ½ liquor license renewal for Off Sale \$100, On Sale \$1,400, and Sunday Liquor \$200, seconded by Lang. MCU

The Barrett C & C has requested to put a storage building at the Community Center to store their belongings. Council had concern about liability insurance. Council decided they would present the option or using a corner of the storage building to make a storage area for the C & C. They will also check into the liability insurance concerns.

Wevley made a motion to contribute \$1,900 to the West Central Area Summer Recreation Program, seconded by Tucker. MCU

Maintenance Report: Having some rusty water problems. Plans to regenerate the water filters and hopes that will help. It could be possible that we have a faulty valve that could be letting some rusty water back into the system. Gerald did flush hydrants. There is a seal out of the sewer pump at the beach, plans to switch it out with a rebuilt one. The Barrett Community Center is in need of paint; however we didn't budget for it this year. He would like to price out putting on aluminum soffit verse painting.

Discussion on the bills was held in reference to the paint job on the grass rig. Lang made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$34,814.82, seconded by Wendt. MCU

Tucker made a motion to adjourn at 7:04 p.m., seconded by Wevley. MCU
