

Barrett City Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, November 9, 2020
5:30 p.m.
Barrett Community Center

Present: Mayor-Todd Lang; Council-Michelle Jenson, Jodi Moss; Clerk/Treasurer-Marita Rhude; Maintenance-Jason Wendt; Water/Sewer Operator-Rodger Smith.

Mayor Lang called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Jenson made a motion to approve the agenda as amended, seconded by Moss. MCU

Moss made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 13th Regular Meeting, seconded by Jenson. MCU

Rodger Smith gave an update on water and sewer.

Runestone Telecom Association has requested the Cable TV franchise to be extended to December 31, 2025. Jenson made a motion to extend the Cable TV franchise with Runestone Telecom to December 31, 2025, seconded by Moss. MCU

Council discussed the proposed Administrative Fine Ordinance that all Grant County Cities are considering approving. Moss made a motion to move forward with drafting an Administrative Fine Ordinance for the City of Barrett, seconded by Jenson. MCU

The City of Barrett received 3 application from businesses and non-profits in the City of Barrett in the total of \$23,476.66, with the City having remaining funds of \$22,856.64. Jenson made a motion to award Prairie Fire Children's Theatre \$494.03, Prairie Wind Players \$2,437.68, and West Central Area Schools \$19,924.93, seconded by Lang. MCU

Moss made a motion to renew Brothers Market Off Sale Liquor License, Prairie Wind Players Wine and 3.2 On Sale License, and Rumor Has It On Sale Liquor License for 2021, seconded by Jenson. MCU

The City of Barrett received payment from Otter Tail Power for an easement on Lake Street in the amount of \$13,159 and also a donation from Runestone Telecom in the amount of \$2,000.

Jenson moved to resolve to accept a donation from Runestone Telecom Association in the amount of \$2,000, seconded by Moss. Roll Call Vote: Jenson-yes, Moss-yes, Lang-yes

Moss made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$19,473.02, check #18709 to #18731, seconded by Jenson. MCU

Moss made a motion to adjourn at 7:11 p.m., seconded by Jenson. MCU
